SHARE Military Initiative

The SHARE Military Initiative at Shepherd Center:

- is a comprehensive rehabilitation program that focuses on assessment and treatment for veterans and service members who have served in the U.S. military since September 11, 2001, regardless of discharge.
- helps veterans and service members who are experiencing symptoms of or have a diagnosis of mild
 to moderate traumatic brain injury or concussions and any co-occurring psychological or behavioral
 health concerns, including post-traumatic stress.
- treats SHARE clients with **no out-of-pocket cost** for the client or their family.
- provides housing options for clients outside a 60-mile radius of Atlanta.
- provides evaluations and treatment in person or virtually and is certified for telehealth in Georgia, Florida, South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia and Tennessee.
- tailors individual sessions tailored to each client's specific needs and goals as well as group sessions with other veterans and current service members.
- Arranges visits with specialists as needed, including a: neurologist, physical therapist, occupational
 therapist, speech therapist, recreational therapist, nurse, case manager, clinical social worker,
 psychologist, vocational specialist, chaplain, peer support, transition support and a substance use
 counselor.
